




Pattern:



Material:

- 80 cm of outside fabric (140 cm wide)
- 60 cm of inside fabric (140 cm wide)
- Vilene to get to outside fabric more stiff.
- 1 zipper (about 20 cm) + sewingthread

Hint: Use very firm fabric for the inside to make the bag stiff.

Specification:

Cut the pattern parts according to the pattern. Cut parts A (2 x) & B of inside and outside fabric. Cut the parts C (2x), D (2x) en E (2x) of the outside fabric. Firm the ouside parts A (2x) & B with vilene. Zigzag the patternparts A, B & E.

Handles:

Patternpart C: Iron the edge to the inside and twofold. Sew the handles on both side on a half sewingfeet distance.



Inside pocket:

Cut 1 patternpart A (inside fabric) in two parts on 15 cm from the bottom.



Cut 1 patternpart E (outside fabric) in two parts on 15 cm from the bottom.



Two-Fold patternparts D and sew them to both sides of the zipper.





Sew the cut in two patternparts A & E to the zipper. Sew on both sides of the zipper with the fabric inside-out and turn (you can zigzag to prevent raffels). Sew again after you have turned on both side of the zipper.













Sew from the outside patternpart E (that was left over and not cut in two) onto the pocket. Spelt the 4 extreme outter corners, so you can see the edges on the right side. Sew on the outside a rectangle, now the pocket has a restricted small inside area.











Inside bag:

Sew patternpart B round to both patternparts A. Make sure that the inside pocket is situated at the bottom.






Outside bag:

Sew the bottompart of patternparts A to the middle of patternpart B.



Sew the handles on both sides 11 cm apart from eachother, connect them in the middle of the bottom together (with broad zigzag stitch), it will give the bag more carrying capacity. Stop at 5 cm from the top free.





Sew the side parts of patternpart A to patternpart B.



Finish:

Put the inside of the bag in the outside part and sew them together at the topside. Fold the two fabric to the inside and sew it round.





Extra bottom part:

Sew or cut a plastic extra bottompart of 41×15 cm (that will prevent the bag from becoming dirty). I used cardboard and glued plastic unto it, this makes the bottom more stiff.





Optional:

Sew extra pockets on the outside. Fold together some outside fabric pieces and sew it between the handles.



The result:
