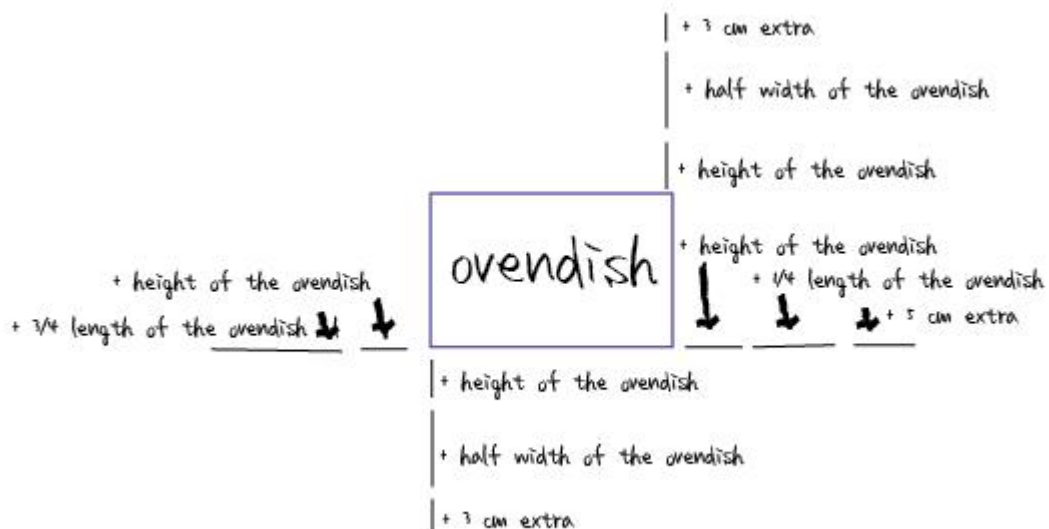


# Ovendishcozy



Nice to wrap a ovendish in and to keep it warm!

Pattern:



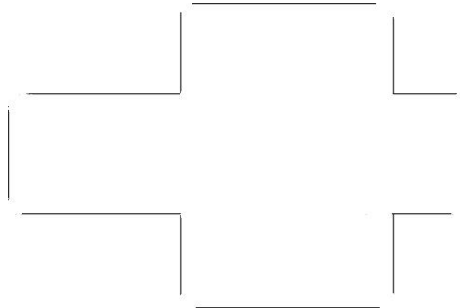
## Material:

- Inside Fabric
- Outside Fabric
- Velcro
- Quiltfilling / watter material

## How to:

### Make your own pattern:

- Put your ovendish backward on paper and draw the contour on the paper.
- Make your own pattern simply to add cm to it on all sides, like it is written down on the pattern above.
- Round the edges. (you can use a cup or a saucer).
- Your own (perfectly fitting) pattern is ready!

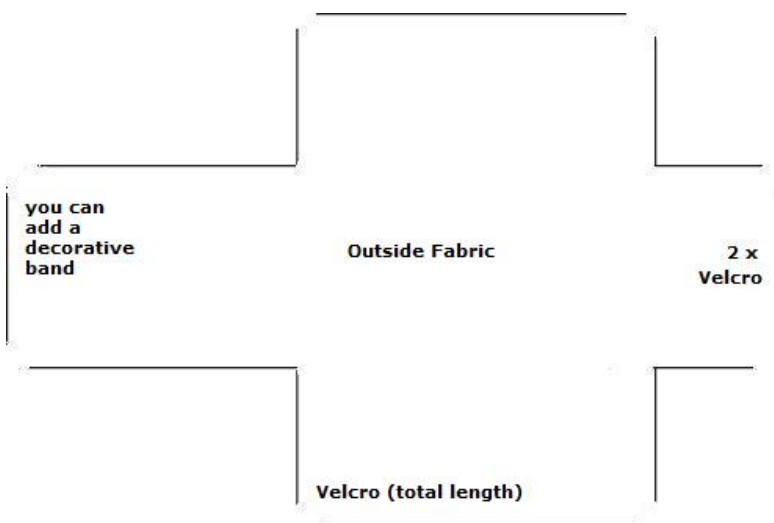


N.B.: my pattern measured 89 cm x 59 cm.

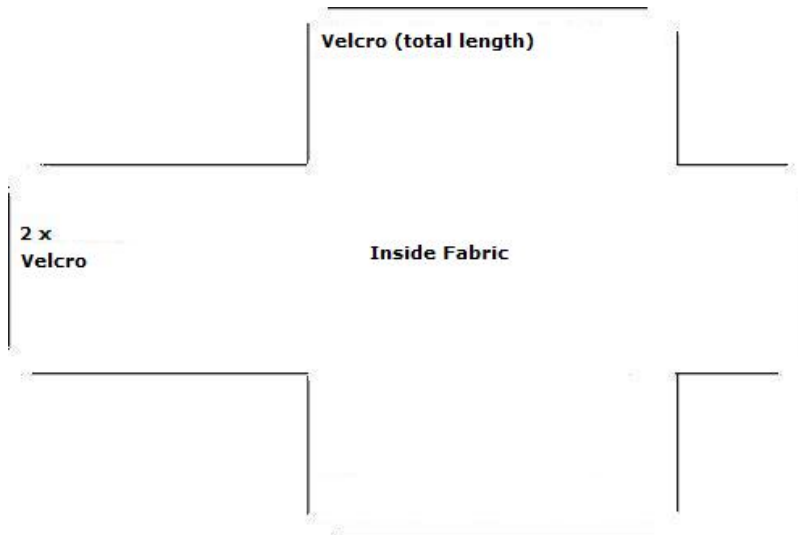
### The making:

Cut the pattern out of outside fabric, inside fabric and watter material (quiltfilling).

Sew Velcro and decorations on the outside fabric like this:



Sew Velcro on the inside fabric like this:



Put the pattern parts with the right sides on each other and place the watter material on top of it. Sew the three parts together and leave an opening to reverse it.





Reverse the cozy inside out and sew the contour again on half a sewingfoot distance.



The cozy is ready!!

If you want to put a set of ovendishes in it, make some protecting, covers so they will not damage each other
